Then we had others sewing the backings together and sewing batting pieces together to make the most of our remnants. People were on hand to press seams open. Others measured and cut batting. Such an amazing production line and cooperation of our members!

Wonderful members saw tops they just couldn't resist and took them home to do the quilting themselves. We appreciate the members that stayed behind to put away tables, chairs and supplies, and help us load our cars. This all made light work of an overwhelming task.
